For organizations using Microsoft Azure Active Directory (AD) as an identity solution – for example for Microsoft 365 applications – cnMaestro X 4.0 adds support for single sign on (SSO) authentication with Azure AD for users accessing Cambium Networks <u>Wi-Fi solutions</u>. IT administrators can now integrate directory services with network access to simplify the end user experience.

In addition, cnMaestro X 4.0 expands its automation facilities with <u>Assists</u>, a solution that helps identify potential vulnerabilities in the network infrastructure across a <u>Cambium ONE Network</u> of devices. Assists helps administrators identify and immediately fix problems to optimize the network fabric and increase overall reliability.

cnMaestro 4.0 also supports the provisioning and management of Cambium Networks' <u>cnWave 5G Fixed</u> millimeter wave fixed wireless solutions.
