Explanation of Responses:

- 1. Represents Class B Units of Vector Cambium Holdings (Cayman), LP ("VCH"), the issuer's parent. In connection with the issuer's Recapitalization (as described in the issuer's prospectus dated June 25, 2019) and upon consummation of the initial public offering, these Class B Units will be exchanged for Ordinary Shares of the issuer, on a value-for-value basis, based on the initial public offering price of \$12.
- 2. These Class B Units vested as follows: 25% vested on February 18, 2014, and the remaining 75% vested in 36 substantially equal monthly installments thereafter, subject to reporting person's continuous service as of each vesting date.
- 3. These Class B Units vest upon completion of the issuer's Recapitalization and consummation of the issuer's initial public offering.
- 4. These Class B Units vest upon achievement of the volume weighted trading average of the issuer's Ordinary Shares, as reported on the NASDAQ Global Market, over 90 consecutive days following expiration of the initial public offering price lock up period exceeding a total equity return multiple of at least 6.0 times, as defined in the original award documents.
- 5. These Class B Units vest as follows: 50% vested on December 31, 2017 upon achievement of bonus targets for 2017, 5% vested on December 31, 2018 upon achievement of bonus targets for 2018 and the remaining vest upon achievement of bonus targets for 2019.
- 6. These Class B Units have no expiration date.
